## WELCOME BACK!!!

As we prepare to return on January 10, 2022 please keep in mind:

Primary and Secondary students must carry <u>at least two face</u> <u>masks</u>, to change during school day (Not applicable for **EC** students).

Please continue to check your child's temperature <u>before they</u> <u>leave every morning</u>. In case of a cold, cough, fever, or flu-like symptoms, please keep your child home.

If any family member(s) tests positive OR comes in contact with a <u>COVID 19 positive case</u>, please self-isolate and monitor symptoms.

Morning <u>drop off</u> and evening <u>pick up</u> have <u>new systems</u>, please read on for more information.

Students having home lunch must carry their snacks/lunch in the morning. No drop offs.

If you need <u>new uniforms</u>, please contact admin@ais.ac.ug for new COVID 19 SOPs.

If you need to meet a member of staff, please seek an appointment via email. No walk-ins.

We are reinforcing the **Exit ID** cards. Please email admin@ais.ac.ug to process a new card.

# Drop off

- 1. The main gate to enter the AIS Campus will open at 7:00 am, starting January 10, 2022.
- 2. **Students** are expected to line up by the **orange cones**. Siblings (or students carpooling) can stand at the same cone. If there are **no vacant cones**, students are expected to **stay in the car**, till there is an available cone. Please **do not crowd**.





- 3. Parents/guardians/drivers can drop and leave, if the child is standing by a cone. If not, please wait till they are standing by a cone. **In case of rain**, please keep the student in the car, till a member of staff comes to you.
- 4. Early Childhood (EC) drop off and pick up will be from the gate in front of the AIS Auditorium.
- 5. Starting January 10, 2022, the exit gate will be open between 7:00 to 9:00 am and 3:30 to 5:00 pm.

## Pick up

- 1. Please contact your child's homeroom teacher to establish what time class ends, and **pick** them up **as soon as class is over**. We do not offer daycare service. If you are running late on a particular day, please inform your child's HoD.
- 2. As you drive in, please park and walk up to the guard at the small entrance gate (or in case of EC, the gate in front of the Auditorium) and present your **EXIT ID**. You can then wait in the car, while the student is called from their homerooms.
- 3. You can use the **EXIT GATE** to leave (check gate timings above).


## \*Special Note\*

While students under the age of 5 are not expected to wear a mask, as per World Health Organisation (WHO), they may still carry/spread the virus. We encourage all Early Childhood (EC) parents to be cautious at home, since many students live in multigenerational households.

Every AIS staff member present on campus has been fully vaccinated (some have even had the booster shot) against COVID 19 before the start of Term 2. We request every member of the AIS Community to maintain the same level of awareness to ensure our safety.

# MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE AND WEAR A MASK WHEN PICKING STUDENTS

We request all parents/drivers/caretakers entering the AIS Campus to pick students to please wear a mask when stepping out of the car. Social distance has to be maintained at all times.

## LITTERING IN THE SCHOOL PARKING

Over the last few weeks, we have noticed an increasing amount of garbage being left in the parking lot after drop off/pick up. Kindly refrain from littering, and also talk to your staff, if they are picking/dropping your child (ren).



#### KEEP STUDENT HOME, IF UNWELL

- Do they know about the metal strip on medical masks, and how it needs to be pinched tight around the nose bridge to fit better?

Based on this conversation, please get them a mask that is most comfortable for all-day use.
